CHAPTER 6

TITLE XX ELIGIBILITY AND REIMBURSEMENT

AUTHORITY: Section 5126.05 of the Ohio Revised Code and 5101:2-25 of the Ohio Administrative Code.

11.1 PURPOSE

The Pickaway County Board of Developmental Disabilities (the Board) shall participate to the extent possible in the Title XX reimbursement program to maximize its revenue. The Title XX reimbursement program will not be used for clients receiving Medicaid Waiver day services or any other day services that are federally funded.

11.2 PROCESS

- A. Under the TXX reimbursement program, the Board shall contract for the provision of Employment Services Workshop (726.01) reported on a per hour basis. Services shall be provided by a certified day services/day habilitation provider. Services delivered are to encompass structured job skills training, job seeking skills, and other skills that promote opportunities for employment. These services will be provided “Without Regard to Income” for clients that meet the eligibility criteria for county board of developmental disabilities services as mandated through Section 5123:2-1-02 of the Ohio Administrative Code and outlined in the Pickaway County Board of Developmental Disabilities Policy Manual and are determined through the Individual Plan to receive Employment Services through a certified day services/day habilitation provider.
- B. The Board shall designate the provider of all programs, services, and/or supports, written in the Individual Plan (IP or IEP), for all consumers for whom the Board intends to receive Title XX reimbursement.
- C. The Board and any subcontractor shall adhere to the proper reporting, billing and documentation criteria as outlined in the Title XX Contract, its Assurances and Attachments.
- D. All records that support claims for Title XX reimbursement shall be made available for any partial or full needs review within a reasonable time following request from the auditing or reviewing authority.

- E. The Board shall maintain in each consumer's current file the most recent IP that substantiates the provision of Title XX services.
- F. The Business Manager shall promulgate procedures and contracts with any subcontracting agency insuring the Board's compliance with this policy and Section 5101:2-25 of the Ohio Administrative Code.
- G. The current Title XX Service Selection & Fee Schedule as provided by DODD (Addendum A1) is considered part of this policy.

This policy goes into effect October 1, 2013.
