



What are the many uses of C-Print?

What is C-Print?

C-Print is a speech-to-text captioning technology and service that provides communication support for individuals who are Deaf or hard of hearing. It allows for the creation of a real-time text transcript of spoken English, and can be used in conjunction with other communication accommodation, such as sign-language interpreting.

- The C-Print software was developed by the Rochester Institute of Technology in New York.
- Uses abbreviations that expand automatically, which allows the captionist to capture discussion quickly and efficiently for added speed and accuracy.
- The transcript can be viewed on another device in front of the client or a projector screen in real-time, allowing them to participate in discussion.
- The transcript can also be saved and emailed to the client after-the-fact.

Who benefits from C-Print?

- People who are Deaf, hard of hearing, who became deaf later in life, or anyone with hearing loss who does not know sign language.
- Individuals with cognitive disabilities, visual impairment, or other physiological challenges.
- Anyone, hearing or otherwise, who wants a detailed written transcript of an event or meeting.

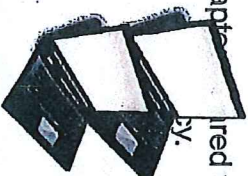
Captionist laptop to client laptop, tablet, or mobile device for one or more individuals.
